Position Title: Part-time Physical Education Instr. Department: CamdenForward School

Position Summary: The physical education instructor will provide maximum physical activity time within the class period, teach skills and activities that transfer into physical activity outside of physical education class, motivate children to be physically active, and take the role of physical activity director for the school.

Essential Job Functions

1. Instruction of K-8 Physical Education classes with enthusiasm, creativity, and sensitivity to student learning styles.
 2. Utilize technology for instructing students, maintaining records, communicating information to parents, and promoting student and Physical Education program achievement.
 3. Provide adequate equipment that allows all children to be active at the same time (e.g., one ball per child).
 4. Encourage and motivate children to be active.
 5. Plan opportunities and perform tasks that are structured for maximum participation (e.g., individual, partner, and small-group activities; no elimination activities; activities that require no wait time).
 6. Structure the class so that learning occurs while students are being physically active.
 7. Help direct and guide opportunities for physical activity within the school outside the physical education class.
 8. Classroom management, utilizing a school-wide positive behavior support model.
