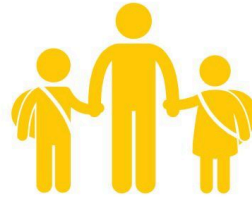

## EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING



**120+** children and youth engaged in healthy cooking classes. Grades 3-8 engaged in weekly hands-on nutrition education classes.

**50** Trekkers (grades 9-12) engaged in journey-based trips that offer cross-cultural experiences, raise environmental awareness, increase historical knowledge, and engage youth in community service. 

**74**  students (in grades 6-12) built four vessels, including two 25' voyageur canoes, a Merrimac canoe, an Abenaki canoe, and an 11' cedar strip single canoe.
